OUR NATIONAL GIVE PARTNER



The Kids In Need Foundation (KINF) is our incredible national give partner. KINF is a 501(c)3 that provides free school supplies to classrooms in need in the U.S. **KINF's mission is to ensure that every child is prepared to learn and succeed.**This mission is supported through a national network of teacher resource centers that includes over 40 facilities. Teachers from low-income schools visit the centers to obtain free school supplies for their students. In 2016, KINF provided free school supplies to over 5 million students and provided material and/or financial support to over 200,000 teachers. **KINF distributes our Yoobi Classroom Packs nationwide through their facilities.** Learn more about our awesome partner at www.kinf.org.

HOW WE GIVE

KINF focuses on elementary schools where at least 70% or more of its students are eligible to receive free or reduced cost lunch through the National School Lunch Program.

We focus on the youngest students first because studies show that creating equal access to school supplies at an early age has the greatest impact on the chances of a child succeeding down the road.



WHAT WE GIVE


For many students, Yoobi Classroom Packs provide the first set of supplies a student can call their own.




